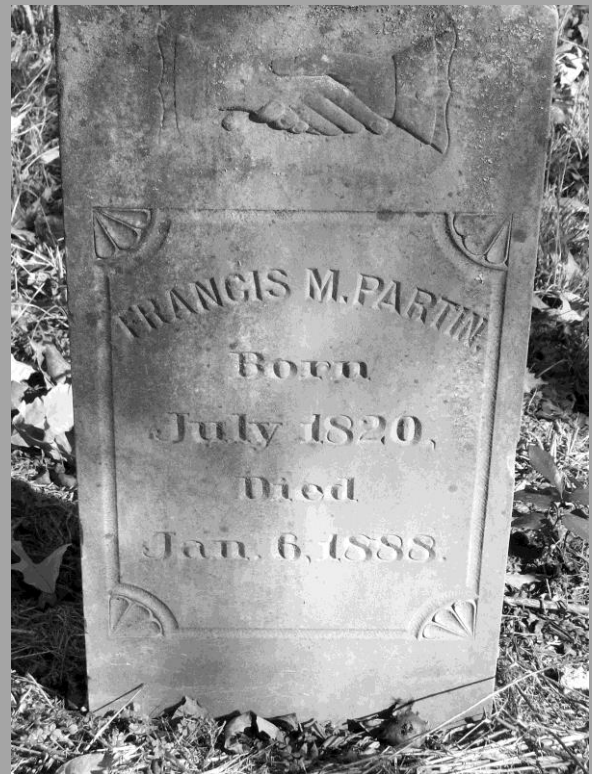


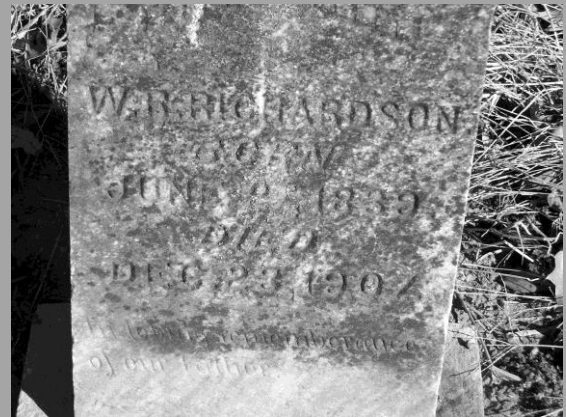
Dear Ancestor

She lived in a house where help was not hired.

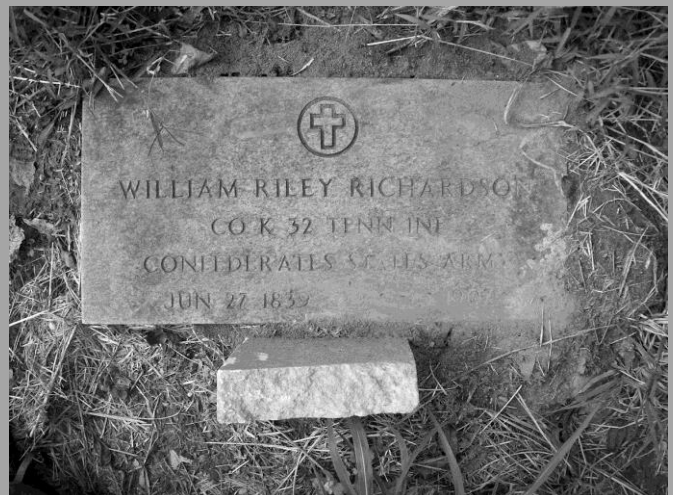
Her last words on earth were: "Dear friends, I am going

I'm going to do nothing forever and ever.





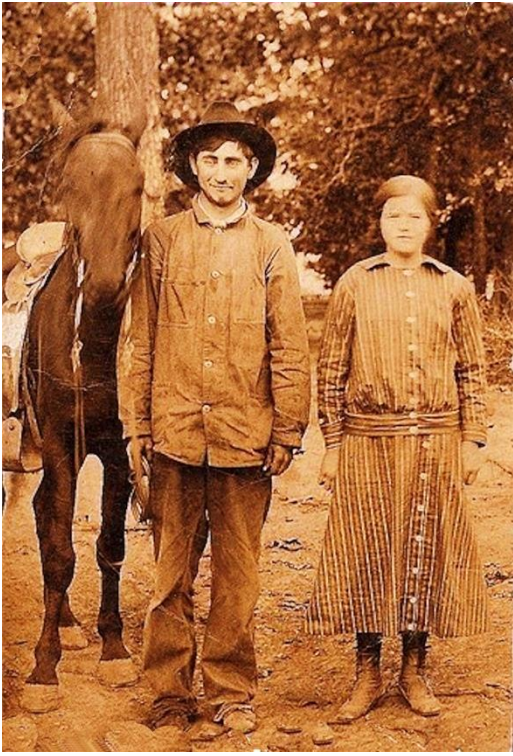

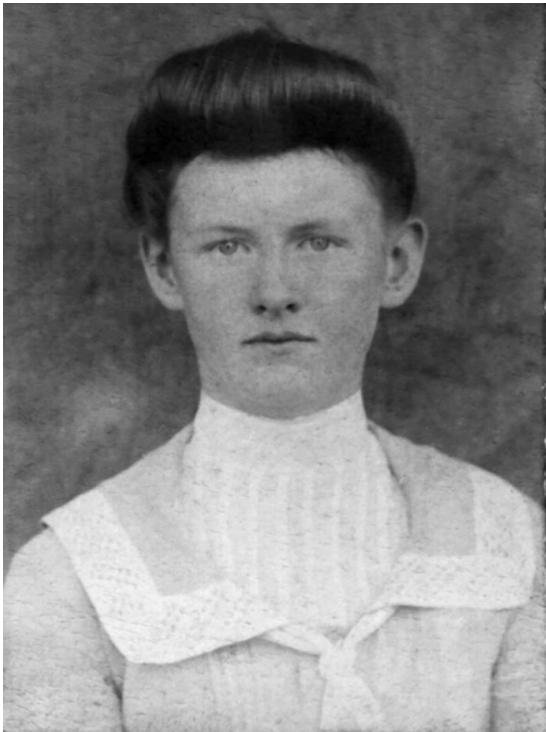
